Concerns: First EURO SUMMER INSTITUTE

We have the pleasure to send you an extended documentation about the First EURO SUMMER INSTITUTE which will be held in Brussels from July 20 to August 10, 1984. This documentation includes:

1. A form to be sent back to me as soon as you will be able to let us know how you will reach Brussels (car, train, plane, ...)
2. A provisional scientific programme

The first week will be devoted to the presentation of the scientific work of the participants. During the second and the third week invited lectures by prominent leading persons in the field of LOCATION will be offered to the participants. Workshops will be organized for thorough investigations. A special issue of EJOR devoted to the INSTITUTE will be prepared starting from the papers of the participants.

The existing papers will not necessarily be submitted to EJOR. Only high standards will be considered. Therefore some papers will be merged, additional work will be achieved, cooperations and exchanges will be encouraged.

Some time will be given to the participants, after the INSTITUTE, to complete the papers for the special issue of EJOR. We expect to submit the final papers to EJOR 4 à 5 months after the INSTITUTE.

In order to encourage cooperation between the participants we ask you to bring with you 15 copies of your own paper. These copies will be exchanged between the participants at the beginning of the Institute.

- The present list of participants (some additional candidates are still in discussion), scientific committee members and invited lecturers.
- The list of the sponsors.
- A map of Brussels. A map of the VUB campus.

The first EURO SUMMER INSTITUTE will start on Friday July 20, 1984. We strongly ask you to arrive in Brussels on this day, if possible between 15.00 and 20.00. We can pick you up at the Central Station (arrival by train) or at the Airport (arrival by plane). You will be accomodated in single student rooms for three weeks. Accomodation, breakfast and all the lunches (one plate - plat du jour) will be offered to you by EURO. Only the evening meals during the week will be at your own costs.

During the week-ends (saturday and sunday) an extended social programme will be offered to you free of charge. (Barbecue visits of Musea, visit of the Belgian Ardennes, of Antwerp, Bruges and the Belgian coast, garden parties, fireworks, ...).

We consider this social programme as very important to develop friendly links between the participants. We hope it will encourage scientific cooperation and fruitful exchanges for the future. The whole INSTITUTE has to be considered as a major EURO investment.

As you see EURO has made a considerable effort to set up an attractive programme. Please do not miss it, we sincerely would regret you.

We are looking forward to seeing you in July next.
