


The abstract submissions

• The abstract submission system was planned to be open

From: Friday, October 29, 2022 Until: Friday, March 4, 2022

• The deadline was extended to: Friday, March 25, 2022. This extension was thought to be helpful for colleagues who were impacted by the invasion of Ukraine, as well as for colleagues from countries in which there were still COVID-19 restrictions, affecting their work-related travel












The abstract submissions

- The length of the abstracts was maintained at 1500 characters
- The area coordinators worked closely with the stream and session organizers to inform the speakers timely about the status of their submissions. This was particularly important given the longer extension that was given to authors to submit their abstract
- The help guidelines for the relevant roles in the construction and delivery of the scientific programme (area coordinators, stream organizers, session organizers, session chairs, speakers) were enhanced












The abstract submissions

- In total, 1946 abstracts submitted, and only a very small number was rejected, namely, 20
- Some of these abstracts were withdrawn by the authors, and others had to be removed because the authors did not register for the conference
- A good number of the cancellations were due to COVID-19, as well as travelling disruptions faced before the conference and as well as during the conference
- The conference counted with 1490 presentations across 449 sessions and 67 streams











Schedule outline






The Plenary and the Keynote Speakers






Aalto Campus

The modern metro connection takes passengers from Helsinki to the campus in less than 15 minutes.









In addition, *Dipoli* was used for various meetings and lunch.











Also *Väre* and *School of Business* hosted technical sessions.


















Sustainability

- A four-day pass (Sunday-Wednesday) for <u>public transportation</u> including buses, trams, metro, commuter trains, and Suomenlinna ferry on zones A, B, and C covering Helsinki city center, Aalto Campus, and the airport
- The registration fee for an accompanying person covers the same except the admission to sessions and conference materials.
