EmC-ICDSST 2019

The **EmC – ICDSST 2019** – EURO Mini International Conference on Decision Support System Technology was organized by the EURO Working Group on Decision Support Systems (EWG-DSS), in cooperation with the Portuguese OR Association APDIO and the University of Madeira (UMA). The Conference was hosted at the UMA in Madeira, Portugal, during the period of May 27th to May 29th, 2019.



The purpose of the EmC-ICDSST 2019 EURO Mini Conference, with its main theme on "Decision Support Systems – Main Developments & Future Trends", was to bring together researchers, developers and specialists in related areas of Decision Making, including its methodologies and technologies, as well as engineers and practitioners directed to the implementation of solutions for DSS challenges in their respective areas of applications. Researchers, computer scientists, engineers, academics, OR and DSS professionals are encouraged to participate and submit their work to the EmC- ICDSST 2019. Members of the EWG-DSS and other EURO related working groups were strongly motivated to take part and to encourage the participation of other related professionals, so that further collaboration within EURO members can be promoted on a larger scale.

The EURO Working Group of Decision Support Systems EWG-DSS was created as a product of the ESI VI EURO Summer Institute on DSS, in the Madeira Island, in May 1989. Since its foundation, the EWG-DSS has organized annual events including workshops, mini-conferences and conference-streams, in order to attend the growing demand for specific approaches of decision making and decision support. These events have received wide participation from researchers, academics, practitioners, developers and other professionals within the EWG-DSS network and colleagues from other international DSS communities and professional societies. Along with the fast increase of the EWG-DSS membership and scale of its events, not only in terms of numbers but also in quality and internationalization, in 2015 the EWG-DSS

decided to re-brand its major annual event as international conference. The ICDSST conferences have the unique title of International Conference on Decision Support System Technology, but with a different theme each year following the trend and state-of-the-art in the DSS field. The conference has a corporate identity with the name of the IJDSST journal, which is the official journal publication of the Euro Working Group on Decision Support System, having published several special issues from research conducted by the group over the last years.







In 2019 the 5th EWG-DSS annual International Conference on Decision Support System Technology (ICDSST 2019 was organized in the format of the **EmC-ICDSST 2019** EURO Mini Conference, with the support of EURO, celebrating the 30th anniversary of the EWG-DSS, back in the Madeira Island. The EmC-ICDSST 2019 aimed at

recapitulating the developments of the Decision Support Systems area in the last 30 years, as well as at enforcing the trends and new technologies in use, so that a consensus about the appropriate steps to be taken in future DSS research work could be established. Since the EWG-DSS creation in 1989, the research area in DSS has substantially advanced and the EWG-DSS has consolidated its importance among the EURO Working Groups, by currently being one of its most stable and active groups considering its research initiatives and activities.

The EmC-ICDSST 2019 EURO International Mini Conference on Decision Support System Technology offered a pleasant and fruitful working environment for all participants, within the beautiful Madeira Island in Portugal.

The EmC-ICDSST 2019 received **64 Work Contributions from 201 authors**, from which we accepted: **11 Long papers**, **28 short papers and 5 posters**, with a total of **157 authors coming from 24 countries**.

We also counted with **56 Reviewers** from the Conference Program Committee, to whom the EWG-DSS Coordination Board is sincerely grateful for their continuous support on the EWG-DSS research activities. 




